

## Hope Wood Academy Achievement Report - Summer 2023 (reporting Autumn 2023)

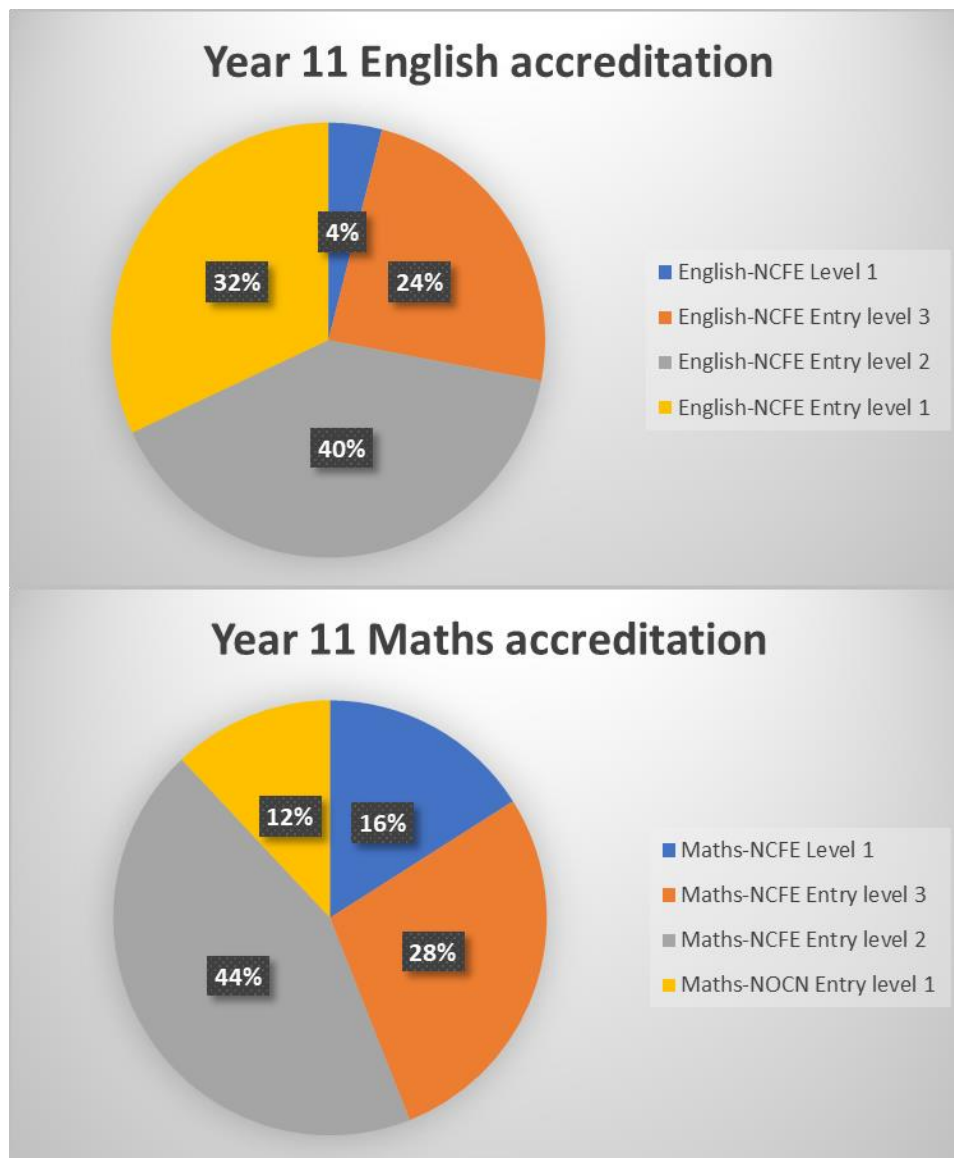
### Year 11 leavers

25 young people in year 11 who all achieved portfolio-based accreditation for maths and English through NCFE at a variety of different levels (entry level 1-level 1) of attainment.

NCFE specification has been used for Hope Wood Academy for several years for key stage 4 young people due to the nature of the nature of the qualification. It allows young people to show progress over time and to allow for application of their skills and knowledge in functional experiences both within the classroom and within the community to increase independence.

Young people also access 'options' where young people are able to achieve in areas of personal interest to them such as sports, humanities and arts.

100% achievement rate.

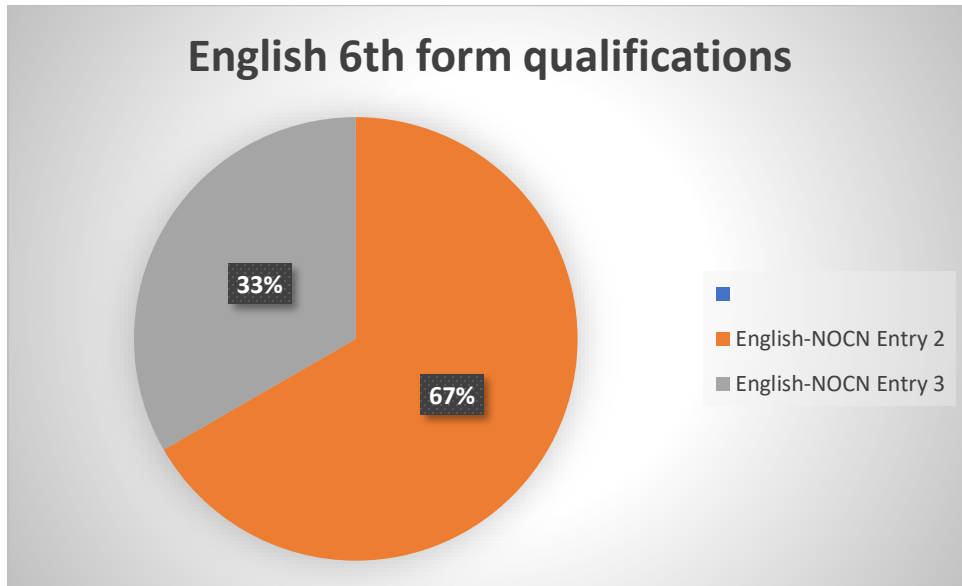

## Sixth Form

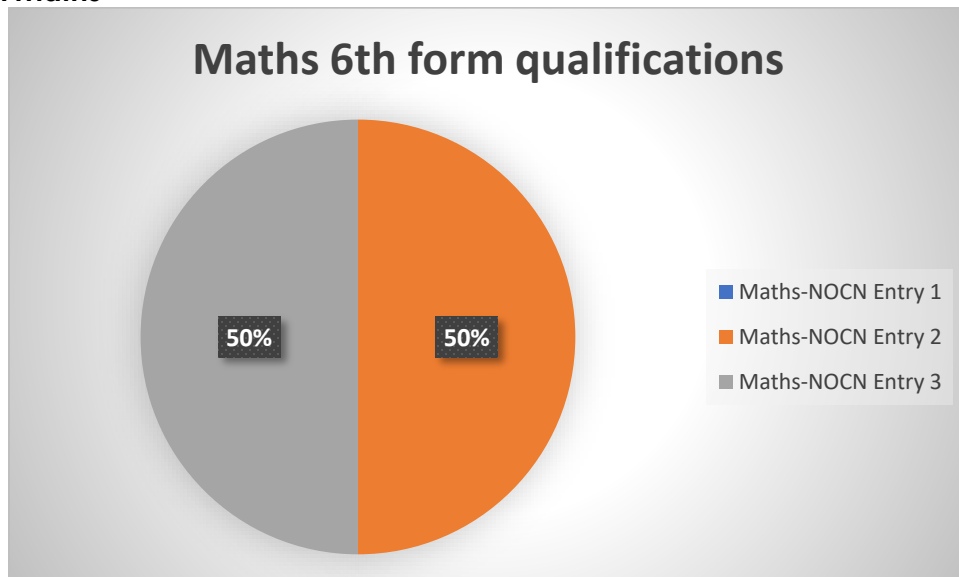
There were 4 leavers in HWA Sixth Form in the summer of 2023. All 4 young people achieved progression with their maths and English through NOCN.
