

Hope Wood Academy Achievement Report - Summer 2024 (reporting Autumn 2024)

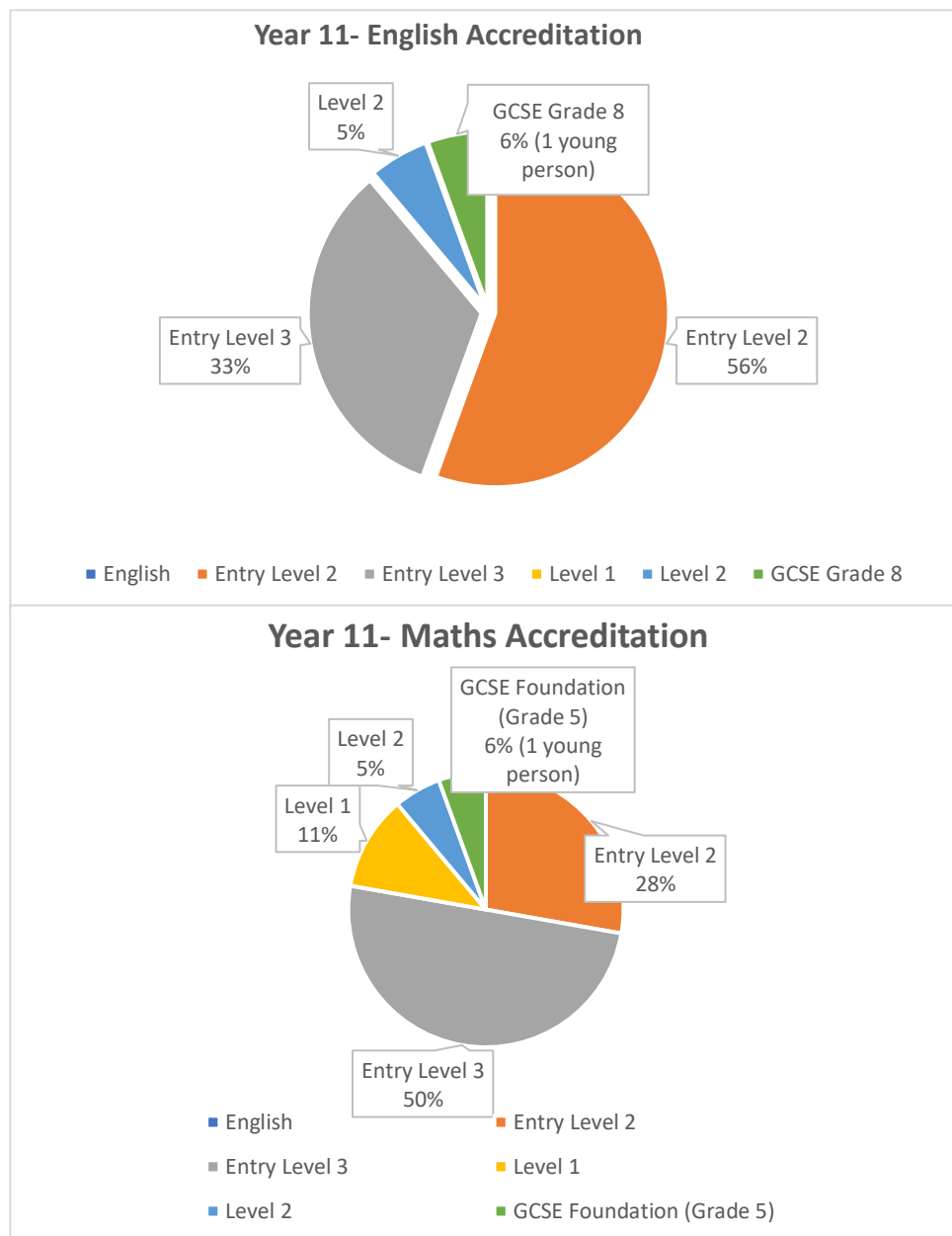
Year 11

18 young people in year 11 who all achieved portfolio-based accreditation for Maths and English through NCFE at a variety of different levels of attainment.

NCFE has been used for Hope Wood Academy for several years for key stage 4 young people due to the nature of the qualification. It allows young people to show progress over time and to allow for application of their skills and knowledge in functional experiences both within the classroom and within the community to increase independence.

Young people also access 'options' where young people are able to achieve in areas of personal interest to them such as Sports, Humanities, Hair and Beauty, Construction and the arts.

Due to the nature of the accreditation the achievement rate for entries would be 100%

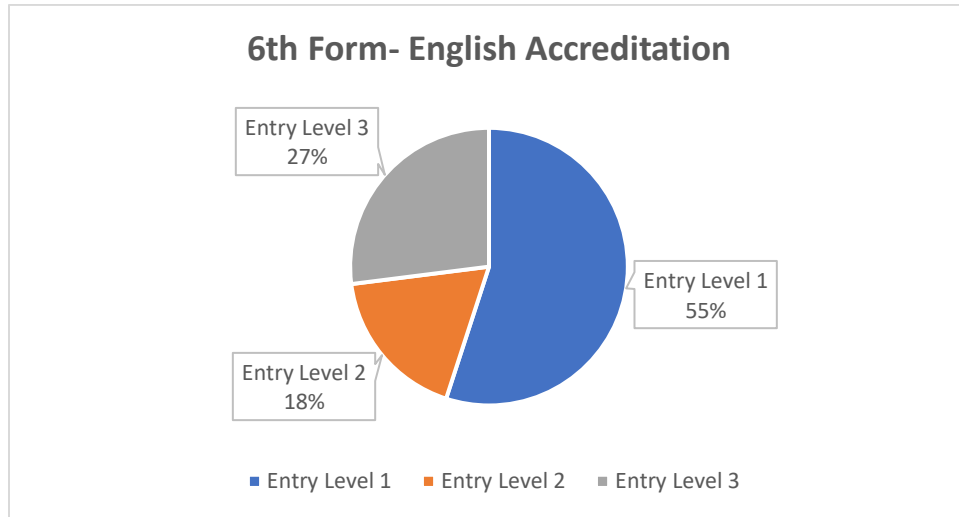

Sixth Form

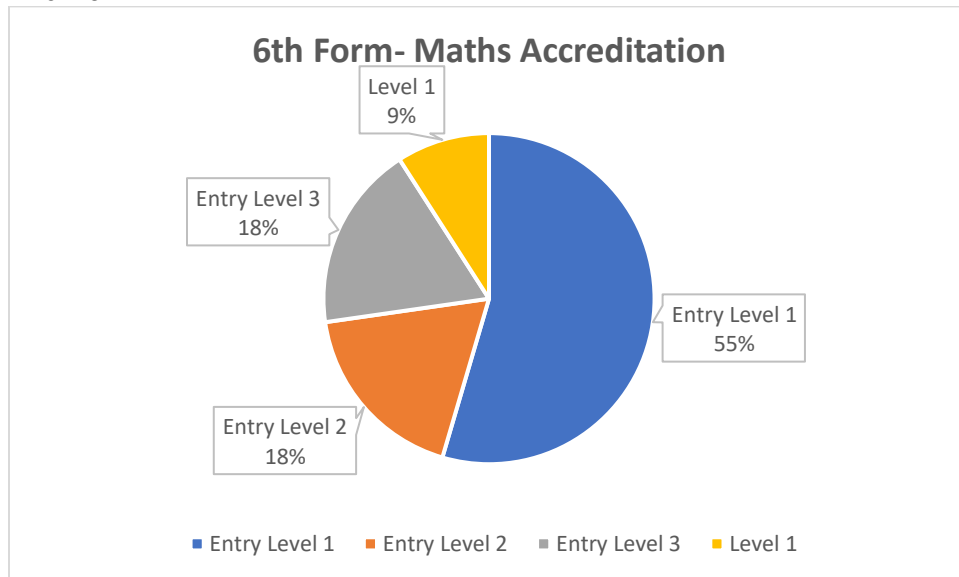
There were 14 leavers in HWA 6th form in the summer of 2024.
