

Leisure - Cinema Exhibitors Association Card

The CEA card is a national card that can be used to verify that the holder (your child) is entitled to one free ticket for a person accompanying them to the cinema. To apply for the card, your child would need to be in receipt of disability living allowance (DLA) and/or be registered blind. The card costs £6 inc postage and is valid for 1 year. General information

There are a lot of venues across the region allow free access to a carer accompanying a disabled child or young person. Usually you would simply need to take along some proof of disability, for example a letter showing DLA entitlement. It is always worth asking.
